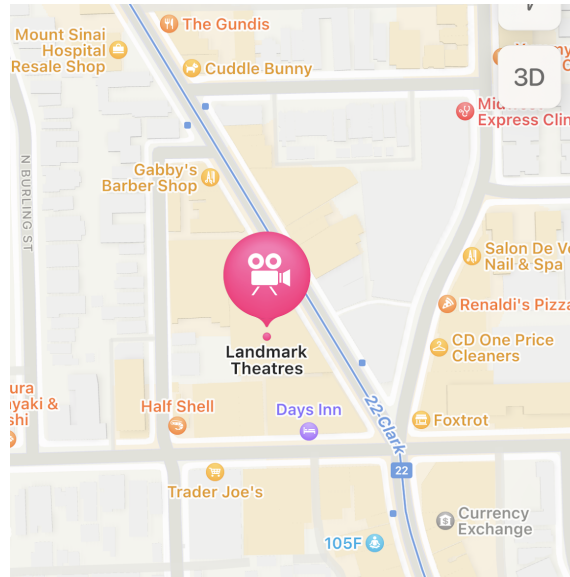
# 1) Getting to Landmark Century Centre Cinema



There are many different ways to get to Landmark Theater.

I could drive, take a Taxi or RideShare, I could have a caregiver park in the garage or on the street, or I could take Public Transportation.

The nearest intersection to the theatre is Clark and Diversey.



## If I am getting dropped off



If my caregiver plans to **drop me off**, or if I am **taxing a Taxi, Lyft, or Uber** to Landmark, I should get dropped off by the main entrance doors on the west side of Clark Street.

## If I am parking at Landmark



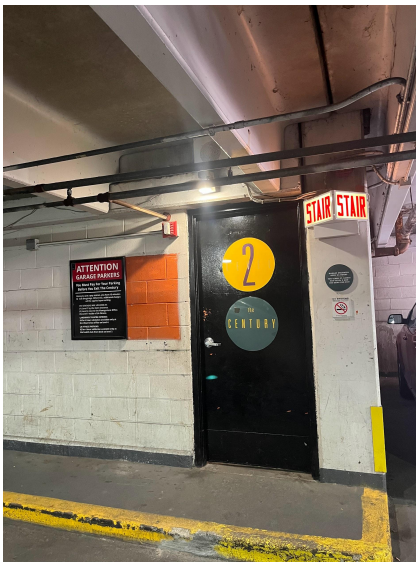
Landmark Theatre has parking in the Century Shopping Centre parking garage.

The entrance to the parking garage is just north of the theater on Clark Street.



With validation, the rate at the Century Centre garage is **\$6 for up to 4 hours**.

I can get my parking ticket validated at the theatre box office.



After I park, I can enter the Century Shopping Center through the nearest door.

Then, I will go to the yellow elevators.

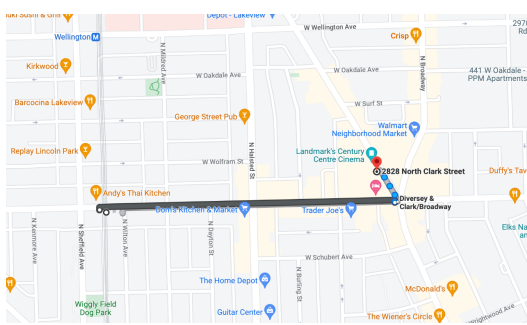


I can also find metered parking along Clark Street.

## If I am arriving via CTA



The nearest El station is the **Diversey Brown Line**.



From the El Station, I will walk **East on Diversey for about 3 blocks**.

Then I will **turn Left (North) onto Clark St.**



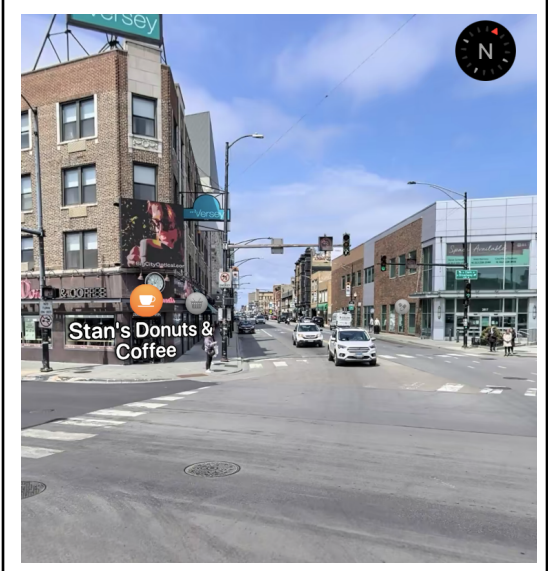
The Landmark Theater will be on my left at **2828 N Clark Street**.



There are also several bus routes that run close to the Landmark Century Center. I could take:

- #22 Clark Bus
- #36 Broadway Bus
- #76 Diversey Bus





I will get off the bus at Clark and Diversey.

## 2) What will happen at the Screening



The main lobby doors at Landmark look like this.



I will walk through the main doors, and follow the hallway to the right.

The hallway looks like this.



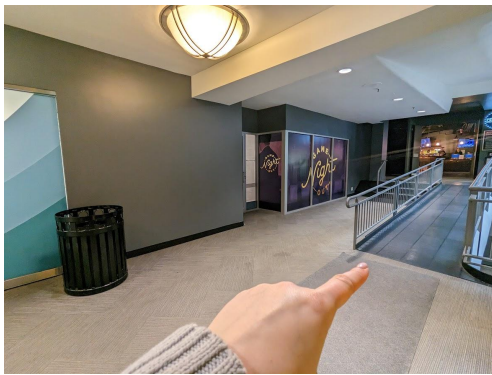
I will keep walking down the hallway to the yellow elevators on my right.



The yellow elevators look like this.



I will take the elevator to the 4th Floor.



When the elevator door opens, I will turn right to get to the Landmark Theater.



There will be a table and ABL signs to welcome me to the screening event.

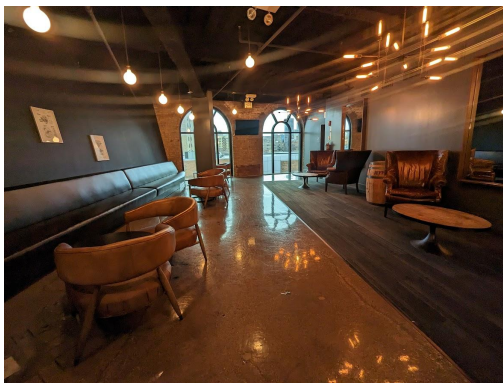
I can use the three stairs to get up to the table, or take the ramp.





After I check in at the registration table, I can go to the reception in the lounge.

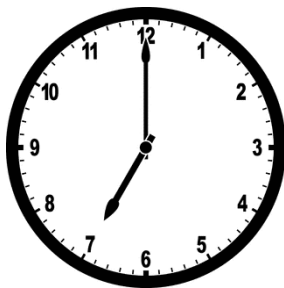
I will walk past the registration and turn left, past the bar and tables.



I will keep walking into the lounge.

There will be a reception with food and beverages from 6:30 to 7:00 pm.

The lounge has some comfy chairs and big windows. There are exposed lightbulbs.



If I do not want to attend the reception, that is okay. I can come at 7pm for the screening.





When the reception ends at 7:00 pm, we will walk together up a ramp, to the theatre.



The Landmark Century Centre Cinema is on the top three floors of an open shopping center.

There are railings, and escalators.

I can look down or up from the hallways.

I should not lean on the railings or over the railings.

If I am scared of heights, I don't have to go near the railing.





***Romeo & Juliet Remix*** will be in Theatre 1.



The entrance to Theatre 1 looks like this.



To get into the theatre, I will walk down a long narrow hallway.



Then I will be inside Theater 1.

There are 147 seats in the theatre.

I can decide where I would like to sit. Other people might sit right next to me. They are all friends of A.B.L.E.



If I need to use the bathrooms, I can leave the theatre and turn right.



The women's bathroom is on the left, and the men's bathroom is on the right.



When it is time for the screening to start, The lights in the theatre will go dark to help us focus on the screen.



I can enjoy the movie!

Some parts of **Romeo and Juliet** are sad or serious.

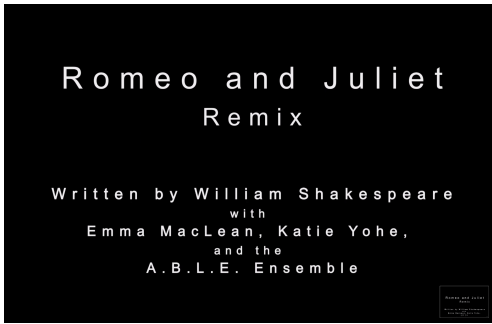


There is music and some loud sound effects.
